

## **Dimitar Abadjiev**



Dimitar Abadjiev graduated from the Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski" and later specialized in "American and International Law" at the Academy of American and International Law - Dallas, USA.

In 1991 he was a bailiff in the District Court - Targovishte, in 1991-1992 - Chairman of the District Court – Omurtag, Vice Chairman of the "Alliance for Legal Interaction" - Sofia and Chairman of the Regional Council of the Union for Democratic Forces (SDS) - Targovishte.

In the period 1997-2009 he was an MP.

In 1997 he was elected as an MP on the list of SDS, in 2000 elected member of the National Executive Council of SDS.

In 2001, he was elected member of parliament, he becomes Deputy Chairman of the Committee on Foreign Policy, Defense and Security; member of the Committee on Legal Affairs; member of the Temporary Commission for the preparation of proposals for changes to the Constitution of the Republic of Bulgaria.

In 2005 he is an MP from the group of Democrats for Strong Bulgaria (DSB), later he becomes a Bulgarian observer in the European Parliament.

In 2007 he became Chairman of civil association "European Democratic Path" (EDP).

From 2004 to 2006, Abadjiev was a Bulgarian observer in the European Parliament.

From 2008 to July 2010, he was the Chairman of the Board of the European Democratic Institute Association.

From July 2010 to 2013, he was the representative of Bulgaria in the management of the project company Nabucco Gas Pipeline International.

In 2015, Abadjiev he is appointed Consul General of Bulgaria in Shanghai, China, in 2016 he becomes Ambassador of Bulgaria in Ljubljana, Slovenia. In 2017 he becomes Bulgarian Ambassador to the newly opened Bulgarian diplomatic post in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.
